### **VI. New Business**

- Ann Marie confirmed that the Boosters Executive Board usually meets two weeks prior to General Booster meetings. At the last Board meeting, the Board voted on the following:
  - Voted unanimously in favor of covering the full cost of uniform shirts for all band, color guard, and percussion students going on the Hawaii trip, as well as the 18 Choir students who are also going on the trip. Total cost approx. \$3164.64 before tax.
  - Voted unanimously in favor of funding the purchase of 5 sets of marching cymbals. Cost approx. \$1259.95 before tax and shipping.
  - Voted unanimously in favor of purchasing 16 crystal stem glasses to be used in an upcoming concert. Cost \$97.89.
